Towards this, the St Paul's Family life Ministry draws this second segment of the calendar that augments its core programs of Marriage encounter cell, Marriage Preparation classes and couples enrichment schedule. In this spirit, we have drawn up 10 topics of reflective sharing to be discussed online every last friday of the month. These borrows from the Apostolic Exhortation Familiaris Consortio as a guide.

29th Mar 2024 | Emerging threats to the family unit (Week 5 - Lenten Campaign 2024)

The family unit remains under threat of many visible and invisible causes. It is in identifying the threats, accepting the challenges they pose to the family that we can put in place counter measures & thrive.

26th April 2024 | The identity and mission of the family

Every particular task of the family is an expression and concrete actuation of that fundamental mission bestowed upon it. It is with the understanding that love forms the reference point to the four general tasks of the family namely: Forming a community of persons, Serving life, Active participation in development of the society and Sharing in the life and mission of the Church (cf;Familiaris consotio,Gaudium et spes) that we shall build cohesiveness and respect.

31st May 2024 | The domestic church: A pillar for evangelization, serving evangelization

The second Vatican Council writes.."the Christian family which springs from marriage as a reflection of the loving covenant uniting Christ with the Church, and as a participation in the covenant, manifests to all people the Saviours living presence. (Gaudium et Spes 48, Familiaris Consotio)

28th June 2024 | The human and Christian demands: Family, work & life balance

Returning to the wisdom of St. John Paul II, "Man ought to imitate God both in working and also in resting, since God himself wished to present his own creative activity under the form of work and rest. ... Therefore man's work too not only requires a rest every 'seventh day,' but also cannot consist in the mere exercise of human strength in external action.

26th July 2024 | The education of children: A primary and inalienable right ..Lessons from Catechism

Parents are the first teachers of the children. We must trustingly and courageously train children in the essential values of human life. For this reason, imparting sex information dissassociated from moral principles and values only serves to open the way to vices instead of imparting knowledge.

30th August 2024 | Nurturing friendship through the Marriage seasons; The fun we lost

The four phases of marriage (Dream stage, Dissillusionment stage, Discovery Stage and Depth stage) can be daughtingly easy or difficult depending on the foundation so set by the couple in the union. All in all, there are some key componets that once ignored sets the union on the rocks. These include but not limited to marital goals, communication, feelings, differences, conflict, intimacy, roles, and being intentional about having fun.

27th September 2024 | Striving for holiness in family, the spiritual growth question

We should follow Christ and become like him, seeking the Father's will in all things, the glory of God and the good of our neighbor. We should use our personal gifts and fulfill our duties in the spirit of faith working through love.

25th October 2024 | The family in Modern times

Many argue that the modern family is an anachronistic institution whose demise is only a question of time. Looking to the family's future, the eminent sociologist Brigitte Berger argues that despite being weakened and embattled, the family will survive as a fundamental social institution. Pope Francis's comments about family in a recent sitting, said family consists largely of a tidal wave of empathy for people struggling with unemployment and low wages, parents who made immature choices and the much bigger existential challenge of how to commit in a world where choice seems limitless.

29th November 2024 | The family hurts, why they hurt deeply

Being betrayed by a friend or a family member is one of the worst feelings ever. Sometimes the emotional pain is far worse than that of physical pain. The question is, how do we handle betrayal? The first thing our flesh wants to do is get revenge. If not physically, then in our minds. But Christ taught us the best way of handling betrayal through washing the disciples feet, dining with all including the one out to betray him.
